STIPULATION AND ORDER TO
EXTEND OBJECTION DEADLINE,
RENOTE FAIRNESS HEARING
AND EXTEND STAY OF
PROCEEDINGS

14 This Document Relates to: ALL ACTIONS

16 This matter comes before the Court on parties stipulated motion to extend objection
17 deadline, renote fairness hearing and extend stay of proceedings. (Dkt. No. 207.) Having
18 reviewed the motion, the Court HEREBY ORDERS:

- 19 1. The objection deadline for the Fairness Hearing with respect to Settlement Class
20 members who are sent a supplemental Class Notice pursuant to paragraph 5(a), below,
21 will be extended to December 10, 2010.
- 22 2. The November 5, 2010, Fairness Hearing will be stricken and renoted to Friday, January
23 7, 2011 at 2:30pm.
- 24

- 1 3. If any Settlement Class member serves an objection prior to November 5, 2010, Class
2 Counsel shall notify the Settlement Class member in writing that the Fairness Hearing
3 has been rescheduled.
- 4 4. Within seven business days of this Order, Class Counsel and Chase shall:
- 5 a. Cause the supplemental Class Notice (Dkt. No. 207, Exhibit 1), with blanks
6 completed and such non-substantive or formatting modifications as may be agreed
7 upon by the parties, to be sent to the approximately 4,500 members of the
8 Settlement Class to whom the long-form Class Notice was not previously mailed.
9 The Class Notice shall be sent by first-class mail, postage prepaid, to the
10 Settlement Class members' last known address;
- 11 b. Cause the supplemental Class Notice to be published on the websites identified in
12 the supplemental Class Notice; and
- 13 c. Cause a notice of the new date for the Fairness Hearing to be published
14 electronically on the Business Wire.
- 15 5. At or before the Fairness Hearing, Class Counsel shall file with the Court a proof of
16 timely compliance with the foregoing mailing and publication requirements.
- 17 6. The stay on the ERISA litigation other than matters related to settlement is extended from
18 October 30, 2010 to December 31, 2010.

19 The Clerk is directed to send copies of this order to all counsel of record.
